

For 20 years, members of Flat Ridge Baptist Church in Cana, Virginia, have been traveling to Jamaica every year, witnessing in churches, the public schools and "on the side of the road."

"We gave out over two thousand tracts in the schools and saw approximately twelve hundred and fifty respond to God's word," writes Pastor Dennis Bledsoe. Using suicide as the topic, they distributed copies of the tract, *No Fear*. At the Kendall School, the principal was in tears after the presentation. She told Pastor Bledsoe that just last week a third-grade student had told her that he had plans to kill himself. "I know God sent you to us," she said.

"This was the most blessed trip in the 20 years we have been going to Jamaica," writes Pastor Bledsoe. Referring to the attached pictures, he says, "You will notice these children were excited to get the



tracts and began reading them at once. We encouraged the students to let their family and friends read them also."

Pastor Bledsoe passed along this statement to those who provided the Chick tracts through the Chick Mission Fund: "The words, 'thank you' seem so inadequate to express my appreciation and gratitude for what Chick Publications has done for our Jamaican Mission work this year."

On the other side of the world, in India, tens of thousands of children were given



In Wycliffe's training of linguists to go to an aboriginal tribe and develop a written language, there is the story about "fairytale markers." It seems that a group of linguists had labored for years learning the language, developing an alphabet, constructing a grammar, and finally translating the New Testament into the language. Printing preparations were made to produce thousands of copies for distribution.

Somehow it was discovered that this tribal language had a certain style of talking in which everyone knew that the story was not true, but was instead, a "fairytale."

Unfortunately, this characteristic was not discovered until the entire New Testament was completed, ready for printing. It was written in the style that told the reader that the whole thing was a made-up story.

In English, we have similar "fairytale markers." A very familiar example is to start a story with the phrase: "Once upon a time...." Immediately, the reader is notified that the following story is a fairytale, not necessarily to be taken as gospel truth. The Wycliffe translators mentioned above had to basically rewrite the New Testament so it would be taken seriously by the tribesmen.

Linguists working on the mission field are not the only ones who run this risk. Linguist and author, David W. Daniels has identified a trend in the modern Bible versions that may, at times, suggest to the reader that the story may be doubted.

A classic example is in the story of Lazarus and the rich man in Luke 16. Jesus spoke this as a true story, not a parable, about a real rich man and a real beggar. Bible dis-believers call this a parable so they can wiggle out of believing in a literal hell. But Jesus said it concerned "a certain" rich man and "a certain" beggar named Lazarus. "A certain" coupled with the beggar's name, indicates that the story is real. However, in 24 modern bibles, including the *English Standard Version* (ESV) and the *Christian Standard Bible* (CSB), "a certain" is omitted. But thirteen other modern versions, including *The*

to major turning points in U.S.-Israeli dealings. In an attempt to spotlight God's warning about those who fail to bless Israel, Jack Chick included a list of recent "coincidences" that happened in unlikely sequence.

Chick tracts as part of a huge Vacation Bible School effort by missionaries and local churches. Binu Joseph Vadaserikara, Director of Excel Ministries writes that six Excel VBS team members traveled to north Indian villages for VBS and tract distribution.

In the village of Allahabad, more than 300 children participated, most hearing about Jesus for the first time. To help

Message and the *Good News Bible* (GNB), also add a word that Jesus never said, "once." This results in something like: "Once there was a rich man..." making it just like a child's bedtime story. This seems like a small point, but coupled with Bibles changing "hell" to "hades" and "sheol," it plays right into the hands of those who claim there is no hell.

This is just one of the risks involved in abandoning a word-for-word Bible translation method (literal or functional equivalence) for the more popular thoughtfor-thought (dynamic equivalence) method used in modern Bible versions.

When a preacher has a preserved, literal translation, he has a solid foundation for his sermon, which he can then interpret to suit the level of understanding of his congregation.

Unfortunately, the only Bible widely available today that provides this solid, preserved and literal text is the King



The big controversy today is Creation vs. Evolution. The Bible says that God created, but atheists and other evolutionists claim that life was first begun by


atoms that moved at random, accidentally forming a first living cell. "It wasn't there; then it was!"


Could all these complex cell parts just happen to bump together to form the first life? No! These cell parts only exist where there are living cells to make them!

up stakes and move to somewhere like Argentina to put an end to the argument over this postage stamp of real estate in the volatile Middle East.

Islam, on the other hand, teaches that whenever any land is ever conquered by Muslims, it forever belongs to Allah. 

ideas of the pope being the anti-Christ and Catholics needing to be born again were now obsolete. This new tactic, called "ecumenism," has succeeded in blunting the Protestant efforts at winning Roman Catholics to full assurance of salvation in Christ.

So, why is this Alpha statement a lie? Do Bible believers really have more in common with Roman Catholics than our differences? 
dict biblical teachings. Jones points out at the beginning that Bible believers and Catholicism disagree at the very basic level: what is the final authority for truth.

showing that Roman Catholic Tradition and something called the "Magisterium" stand equal with the Bible in authority. In fact, the Magisterium trumps the Bible because it delegates to the "church" the sole right to interpret the Bible.

Thus, when Catholics are told it is okay to read the Bible, they are warned that they won't understand it because they need the "church" to explain it to them. For example, where Mark 6:3 speaks of Jesus having brothers and sisters, Rome teaches that these were actually cous-

ins or other relatives because Jesus' mother, Mary, was a perpetual virgin after she gave birth to Jesus. (See also Matt. 13:55 and Galatians 1:19.) This interpretation is necessary because it would not be appro-

priate for the Virgin Mary goddess to have born other, normal children.

Jones goes on to explain how Roman teaching on salvation is unbiblical since it must come through the "church" and not through Christ alone. And it is not simple salvation by faith, alone, but requires certain good works and rituals.

Couple these with other unbiblical teachings such as purgatory, worship of the wafer god, the

pope's priestcraft hierarchy, infant baptism, prayer to saints, bowing to idols. confession to a priest instead of God, forbidding to marry, and vain repetition in prayer, and there is no way that what we agree on is greater than what we disagree on. Let's expose



14 BattleCry - Mar/Apr 2012 Truth Compromised is Still a Lie

We hear a lot about Christians "engaging in dialogue" with other groups and religions: Muslims, homosexuals, Catholics, etc. But should a Bible-believer do this? What is this "dialogue" everybody wants us to "engage" in?

When we take a closer look, what they want is not really dialogue —it's dialectic, a very old Jesuit principle.

Dialectic involves three aspects: thesis, antithesis, and synthesis. These sound complex, but "thesis" and "antithesis" are simply names for two opposites. "Synthesis" is a word for the compromise people reach in order to come to some form of agreement.

Here's the problem: what if the thesis happens to be the truth? If one side is the truth, then the other side —antithesis— has to be a lie. But what is the synthesis? Any compromise between truth and a lie is also a lie. So, actually, if you talk about which side wins, the lie wins out, because a lie is always a lie. It never becomes the truth. Truth compromised is still a lie.

But before the eyes of God, everyone loses in this kind of dialogue, or dialectic. What we need is truth, not compromise. We need to persuade the other side to the truth of our side. Then everybody wins and there's no compromise.

Look at the story of Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego. They're standing up there by themselves, because everybody else is fallen down on their faces in front of this giant idol. So the king calls them out by name and says in effect, "Didn't you hear my decree? I don't care who you are; when you hear the music, you fall down just like everybody else!"

The three could have said, "You know, we could just bow our heads down. That'll be good enough." But then they would be just as bad as everybody else. They might as well be on their faces in front of the idol. Tilting your head is still compromise. It's still not what God commanded in His word. Instead, they said, "If it be so, our God whom we serve is able to deliver us from the burning fiery furnace, and he will deliver us out of thine hand, O king. But if not... we will not serve thy gods, nor worship the golden image which thou hast set up" (Daniel 3:17-18).

Thesis stayed thesis, and antithesis stayed antithesis. There was no synthesis. In fact, the king in his fury commanded them to heat the fiery furnace seven times hotter, so hot that his mightiest men, who threw them in, died of their burns.

But God protected those three. And even if He hadn't, they just would've gone to meet Him. But this time He came to meet them! And when they came out they didn't even have the smell of fire —or the stink of idolatry on them. They stayed with their thesis. They had no guilt of compromise. For them there was no synthesis.

It didn't matter whether they were afraid or not, because that was not the point. It didn't matter. What mattered was their refusal to compromise. And God completely honored it.

God bless you and give you boldness. Here's your scripture for today, beloved. Look it up: Proverbs 28:1. If you don't... shame on you.


